



## Community Festive Photo 2020 Competition Rules

Whitehill Town Council is hoping to help encourage the community to get into the festive spirit with their Festive Photo Competition.

### Competition Rules

- The competition is free to enter.
- The competition is open to all ages.
- In the event that your photo entry involves an individual believed to be under the age of 18, written parental approval for use of the image will be required on submission.
- Please get the permission of any premises owner prior to entering any photo of their property into the competition. The exception for permission requirements being any public land or properties visible from the outside without directly accessing property.
- The council will take no responsibility for any damage caused or injury sustained whilst taking entry photos for the competition. Please ensure that you act legitimately at all times, with all due care and attention to ensure the safety of yourself and others and that social distancing is maintained in line with latest government guidelines.
- Prizes will be awarded for the top 3 festive photos.
- **To enter:** Please submit a photo of your entry with your name, address and contact number. Entries may be submitted by e-mail to [katie.anscomb@whitehilltowncouncil.gov.uk](mailto:katie.anscomb@whitehilltowncouncil.gov.uk). No postal entries will be considered due to current COVID-19 controls. In line with GDPR this information will be retained short term for the purpose of this competition only.
- **Closing date:** Entries must be received by 5pm on 31st December to be eligible for entry. Judging will take place throughout the festive period as entries are received.
- No monetary prizes will be applicable or offered in substitution for trophies.
- Recycled and environmentally friendly decorative entries and those that showcase our wonderful community and its members are particularly encouraged.
- Prizes will be announced and awarded on completion of all judging after the closure date.
- If no one is available at the winning address to accept the award, arrangements will be made for an alternative time slot up to the end of January 2021.
- The decision of the judging panel will be final. Prize winners will be made public and announced to the local press shortly after judging.
- Preference will be given to any entry nominated from within the Parish of Whitehill (which includes Bordon).
