WHITEHILL TOWN COUNCIL MINOR GRANT AID AWARDS

Five organisations will receive a grant from Whitehill Town Council as part of its Minor Grant Aid scheme to help with running costs and purchasing equipment.

A meeting of the Council's Policy & Resources Committee on 18th April agreed to award grants of almost £6,000 to support organisations which provide services and activities to the Whitehill & Bordon community. The following grants were awarded:

- i) £600 to 1st Blackmoor & Whitehill Scout Group to purchase outdoor cooking equipment.
- ii) £500 to Grayshot Cricket Club towards the cost of purchasing replacement site screens.
- iii) £1,500 to Homestart towards core costs.
- iv) £2,639 to TLC – Hospice Services at Home towards core costs.
- v) £593 to Whitehill & Bordon War Memorial Association to purchase a new tent and towards insurance costs.

Whitehill Town Council also runs a Major Grant Aid scheme and has now awarded grants of nearly £52,000 for this financial year, with a further £3,000 earmarked to two organisations.

Cllr Adam Carew, Leader of Whitehill Town Council, said "I am thrilled that we were able to give all our applicants everything they asked for, they were all deserving causes and our grant aid will enable them all to do even more for our local residents."
